OGWA Picnic-Campout - August 2-4, 2024

Here is general information we think will be helpful in your planning:

- Pelton Park Store & Marina (the park store) offers groceries, ice, fishing tackle, boat rental and fuel. They even have a grill and serve breakfast and lunch. See the marina website at peltonparkmarina.com for more information.
- Lake Simtustus (the lake) has a small water skiing area, but most of the lake has a speed limit of 10 miles per hour and is ideal for fishing, canoeing and kayaking.
- Fishing In order to fish Lake Simtustus you will need to purchase a Tribal permit. These are available at the park store. You will also need your Oregon fishing license.
- Boating/Personal Water Crafts (Jet Skis) In 2009, Oregon's mandatory boater education law requires ALL Oregon recreational power boaters operating craft of greater than 10 horsepower (hp) to complete an approved boater education course and apply for an Oregon Boater education Card. This card is required for anyone operating the craft and must be carried on board. The law includes PWCs (personal watercrafts) with engines over 10 hp. The law also establishes special requirements for younger boaters. You can find an online exam and more information at www.boatoregon.com. The lake is patrolled by the county Sheriff so please be aware of boater safety rules and abide by them.
- ★ Boat Moorage There are boat slips available at \$20.00 per night. Boat trailers can be parked in the parking lot. Boat rentals (including paddle boats, patio boats & kayaks) are available. For more information call Pelton Park Store & Marina at (541) 896-4710 or peltonparkmarina.com.
- **Swimming** Bring your swimsuits, life jackets and sunscreen! There is a swim area in the park!
- → Pelton Wildlife Overlook Just north of Pelton Park, you can view ducks, geese, great blue herons, shorebirds, eagles and other raptors. Short trails lead to viewing platforms overlooking the Pelton Reservoir.
- RVs (trailers, motor homes or 5th wheels) You may fill up your water holding tank upon entering the campground (faucet available). All RVs must be self-contained and dumped on your way home at a RV waste disposal station. Some RV sites have electricity, some do not.
- ♣ Pets Pets are allowed but must be on a leash at all time, not left unattended and animal waste must be picked up immediately and placed in garbage containers. Pes are not allowed in Yomes or Cabins.
- ☆ Firewood Available for \$5 per rack (2 ft. x 2 ft. bundle).
- ☆ Park Entrance Gate Closes at 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
- ☆ Check-in/Check-out Check-in time is 2:00 p.m. on Friday or as campsites become available. Check-out time is 12:00 p.m. on Sunday.
- ☆ Directions Turn west off Hwy 26 one mile south of Warm Springs onto Pelton Dam Road. Go 3.5 miles to Pelton Park Campground.
